Keeping students safe

The wellbeing and safety of every student I work with is fundamental to the way I provide educational advice.

Dare Education works with students and families at important points in their educational journey. I take my responsibilities towards young people seriously and work in a way that is appropriate to their age, circumstances and level of independence.

Working with students under 18

Where I work directly with a student under 18, parents or guardians remain an important part of the relationship. I aim to give students appropriate space to express their views and take part in decisions about their education, while maintaining clear and appropriate boundaries around confidentiality and parental involvement.

Communication with students is kept professional and appropriate to the nature of the work.

Confidentiality and safeguarding

I treat information shared with me with care and discretion. The approach to personal information and confidentiality is set out in the Dare Education Privacy Policy.

Confidentiality cannot be guaranteed where there is a concern that a student may be at risk of harm or where information needs to be shared to protect their safety or wellbeing.

If a safeguarding concern arises, I will take appropriate action and, where necessary, share relevant information with a parent, guardian or appropriate professional or authority.

Professional boundaries

Dare Education provides educational advice and does not replace the role of a parent, school, healthcare professional or other specialist service.

Where a student's circumstances indicate that additional or specialist support may be appropriate, I may recommend that the family seeks advice from an appropriately qualified professional or organisation.

DBS and safeguarding training

I am registered with the DBS Update Service. I have also completed Level 3 Designated Safeguarding Lead training.
